## Monthly Statistics Report News Release

July 2001

September 17, 2001 - REVISED

NAPLES, FL. -- The Conveyor Equipment Manufacturers Association reported that its July 2001 Booked Orders Index was 172 up 18 points or an increase of 12% from June 2001's Index of 154 (1990=100). The July 2001 Index represents a decrease of 39% from the July 2000 Index of 283.

July Booked Orders Indexes were 87 for Bulk Handling Equipment\* and 199 for Unit Handling Equipment\*(1990=100).

The Twelve-Month Index for Booked Orders was 167 in July. The index represents a decrease of 5% from June 2001's Twelve-Month Index of 176.

The CEMA Billed Sales (shipments) Index was 276 in July up 38 points or an increase of 16% from the June Index of 238. The July 2001 Index represents an increase of 1% from the July 2000 Index of 264.

July Billed Sales Indexes were 90 for Bulk Handling Equipment\* and 296 for Unit Handling Equipment\*(1990=100).

The Twelve-Month Index for Billed Sales was 256 in July. The index represents an increase of 1% from June 2001's Twelve-Month Index of 255.

\* Since Bulk Handling Systems booked and billed sales are reported quarterly, they are averaged back to the two preceding months to enable a running monthly index.
