NAPLES, FL. — The Conveyor Equipment Manufacturers Association reported that its June 1999 Booked Orders Index was 223 representing an increase of 29% from May's 1999's Index (1990=100). The June 1999 Index represents an increase of 36% from the June 1998 Index of 164.

June Booked Orders Indexes were 94 for Bulk Handling Equipment* and 257 for Unit Handling Equipment" (1990=100) .

The Twelve-Month Index for Booked Orders was 172 in June. Index represents an increase of 3% from May 1999's Twelve-Month Index of 167.

The CEMA Billed Sales (shipments) Index was 227 in June representing an increase of 21% from the May Index. The June 1999 Index represents an increase of 7% from the June 1998 Index of 212.

June Billed Sales Indexes were 108 for Bulk Handling Equipment* and 223 for Unit Handling Equipment" (1990=100) .

The Twelve-Month Index for Billed Sales was 198 in June. Index represents an increase of 1% from May 1999's Twelve-Month Index of 197.

Since Bulk Handling Systems booked and billed sales are reported quarterly and are averaged back to the two preceding months, the booked and billed indexes for non-quarter ending months for Bulk Handling Equipment and Category X, total of all categories, are adjusted quarterly.

Effective with the January 1999 report, sales for conveyor chain were added to the booked and billed sales indexes for Unit Handling Equipment.
