Monthly Statistics Report News Release

November 2001

NAPLES, FL. -- The Conveyor Equipment Manufacturers Association reported that its November 2001 Booked Orders Index was 121 down 63 points or a decrease of 34% from October 2001's Index of 184 (1990=100). The November 2001 Index represents an increase of 7% from the November 2000 Index of 112.

November Booked Orders Indexes were 71 for Bulk Handling Equipment* and 137 for Unit Handling Equipment*(1990=100).

The Twelve-Month Index for Booked Orders was 158 in November. Index represents an increase of 1% from October 2001's Twelve-Month Index of 157.

The CEMA Billed Sales (shipments) Index was 197 in November down 42 points or a decrease of 18% from the October Index of 239. The November 2001 Index represents a decrease of 16% from the November 2000 Index of 235.

November Billed Sales Indexes were 72 for Bulk Handling Equipment* and 208 for Unit Handling Equipment*(1990=100).

The Twelve-Month Index for Billed Sales was 250 in November. Index represents a decrease of 1% from October 2001's Twelve-Month Index of 253.

* Since Bulk Handling Systems booked and billed sales are reported quarterly, they are averaged back to the two preceding months to enable a running monthly index.
